Greetings from DAAD Thailand

2021 has been another year of rapid change and transformation. One of our successful tasks is that the DAAD has reached more and more students and researchers in Thailand. It has always been a great pleasure to help and support all of you with necessary information, consultations and exclusive information events. Now the first quarter of 2022 is running fast, however; we would like to extend our warmest wishes for a safe, healthy and successful year to our partners and network.

In light of the ongoing COVID-19 pandemic, German universities try to minimize the risk of infection by following the 3G rule and offering safe conditions for in-person teaching. Classes of upcoming summer semester 2022 will be conducted under restrictions. We recommend you to get in touch with the respective university or research institution to inquire about the current situation.

The DAAD Thailand has been offering only online consultation since April last year. Due to current rising number of COVID-19 cases, we decided to observe physical distancing by offering only online consultation until 30 April 2022. We hope the situation will get better during this summer so that we can meet you in person at our office.

This year, we have planned to organize the 4th Falling Walls Lab Thailand onsite together with our partners in Bangkok. The event is scheduled to be held in June 2022 (TBC) and we really hope to welcome all participants with their breakthrough ideas both globally and locally. Moreover, the DAAD and Chulalongkorn University plan to host an academic conference for German Studies in November 2022. University lecturers in the Southeast Asia will be invited to join the con-



ference and share their research topics or experiences in the fields of German Studies and German as a Foreign Language.

Apart from these two big events, we are looking forward to visiting schools and universities in Thailand during our roadshows and information sessions. We are always glad to be invited to information sessions or study fairs which arranged by schools and universities. Right now, we slowly get used to an online platform that allows us to organize events and reach more people despite the travel restrictions and social distancing measures.

Let's sum up the first quarter of 2022 with the good news! We are happy to see many applications for DAAD scholarships submitted last year from Thai applicants. The result of some Master scholarship programmes has been announced and we already have six scholarship holders who will travel to Germany this year. Regarding to the spread of the coronavirus which affects study environments worldwide, the DAAD continuously adapts its funding programmes to the dynamic pandemic situation. Due to our organizational restructuring, there are currently only two local staff at DAAD Information Centre in Bangkok. Please apologize for our late response. We'll do our best to support you!

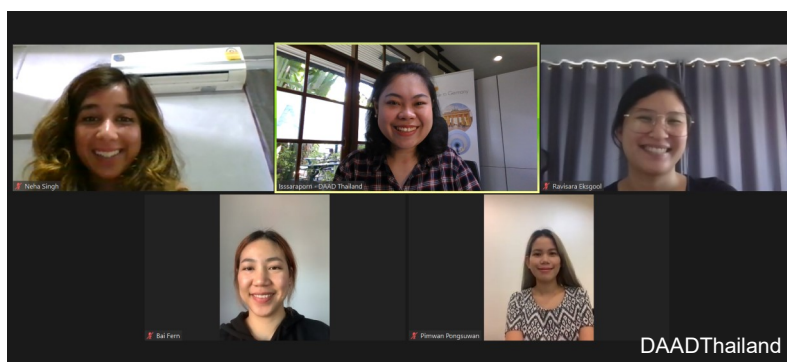

What is Studienkolleg?

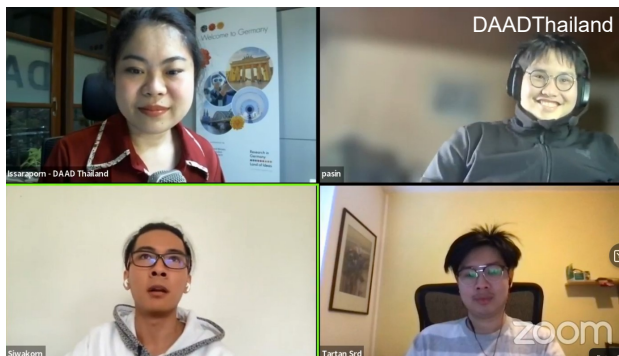
Should the school certification does not qualify for direct entry to German universities, students need to visit a preparatory course called „Studienkolleg“ for two semester (one year) and complete the „Feststellungsprüfung“ (university qualification exam) before applying to German universities.

For all Thai school graduates, the Mathayom 6 is not yet equivalent to German university entrance qualification (German Abitur). That's why attending Studienkolleg will be needed for those who would like to apply for Bachelor's courses in Germany. If you have graduated with other international school-leaving qualification, please check the requirements from our [database on admission requirements](#).

What were we talking about in this event?

On 21st January 2022, we have interviewed three Thai engineering students about their experiences as international students in Germany starting from the preparatory course to university. They shared many tips for passing the Studienkolleg as well as the Feststellungsprüfung. We have learned about the difference between private and state Studienkolleg which is very useful for all applicants who would like to find another option for preparatory course in Germany. At this point, we would like to thank all our special guests again for sharing their experience with us.
